- Embroiderers' Guild of WA: Selected Works from the Historic Collection The Embroiderers' Guild of WA (Inc) maintains an important Collection of hand embroideries and lace, contemporary and traditional, with local, national and international pieces. - <u>Designing Women: Contemporary Textile Arts</u> is a Perth-based group of textile and fibre artists. Their exhibition at Fibres West is inspired by the Flower Power theme. One thing is guaranteed: it will be colourful, diverse, and totally engaging. We can't wait. Join us to celebrate all things fibre art. The exhibition closes on Friday July 7 at 1.30pm
- <u>Judith Pinnell Display (and Sale) of Art Works</u> Textile artist Judith Pinnell is known internationally for her exquisite silk paper creations (about which she wrote 2 books), which exemplify her love of colour, design, medieval history, and embroidery. A selection of her work and teaching samples will be displayed and available for sale at Fibres West 2023. All funds raised are donated to Fibres West Inc. This special display will open at the Art Bazaar on the Tuesday evening of Fibres West, and run until Friday morning July 7. Not to be missed it's the chance to 'snap up' one of Judith's works; never to be repeated.
- The 15 x 15 Creative Challenge Exhibition of works created (and donated) by participants at Fibres West 2023. This fabulous, inclusive, and diverse exhibition opens on Wednesday afternoon at 5pm and runs until Friday midday. ALL works will be available for sale at only \$15 each. Don't miss it.
- Reclaim the Void Reclaim the Void was born from Ngalia elders in Leonora, Western Australia, expressing their pain and grief at 'those gaping mining holes left all over our country'. The project is a collaboration by Vivienne Robertson and the Ngalia Heritage Research Council (Aboriginal Corporation) represented by cultural custodian Kado Muir. Together, they seek to raise awareness of the story of country, and symbolically 'heal' the scarred physical and cultural landscape. Based on an original painting by Ngalia artist Dolly Walker, thousands of handmade circular rag-rugs are woven from discarded fabric by people from all walks of life and backgrounds. At Fibres West 2023, everyone is invited to contribute to the project by way of some rug weaving. Do a little, or a lot every contribution is valued. Meet Reclaim the Void volunteer Fiona Stuart on Sunday and Wednesday afternoon. The rugs woven at FW23 will be 'tagged' with Fibres West 2023 in the digital rugalogue.
